| A. Africa           | 1. Trade that is fair for everybody—a fair wage for workers, a fair price for companies, a positive connection for consumers who receive a quality product.  |
| B. Asia Pacific     | 2. To divide and distribute in fair portions.  |
| C. Canada           | 3. To bring out the possibilities – to grow and mature. Also a term used to describe how people can create a better life for themselves, their children and their communities.   |
| D. CIDA             | 4. The world’s second largest country, occupying most of northern North America, extending from the Atlantic Ocean in the east to the Pacific Ocean in the west and northward into the Arctic Ocean.   |
| E. Communities      | 5. The world’s second largest continent, surrounded by the Mediterranean Sea to the north, the Suez Canal and the Red Sea to the northeast, the Indian Ocean to the southeast, and the Atlantic Ocean to the west. With more than 900 million people (as of 2005) in 61 territories.   |
| F. Conscience       | 6. The quality of right relationship.  |
| G. Development      | 7. The PWRDF Youth Initiative.   |
| H. Emergency relief | 8. The international development agency of the government of Canada known as the Canadian International Development Agency   |
| I. Empathy          | 9. The careful management of something entrusted to one’s care.  |
| J. Fair Trade       | 10. The action of understanding, and being sensitive to the feelings and experience of another.  |
| K. Fairness         | 11. Territories in the Americas where the Spanish or Portuguese languages prevail: Mexico, most of Central and South America, plus Cuba, the Dominican Republic and Puerto Rico in the Caribbean.  |
| L. Indigenous       | 12. PWRDF relationships based on shared values, equity, accountability, autonomy, communication, inclusiveness, openness, transformation and solidarity.   |
| M. Justgeneration   | 13. Marked by honesty, free of favouritism and prejudice.  |
| N. Justice          | 14. Having originated in a particular environment.   |
| O. Kairos           | 15. A term generally applies to East Asia, Southeast Asia and Australasia near the Pacific Ocean, plus the states in the ocean itself (Oceania).   |
| P. Latin America    | 16. A situation that happens suddenly, including earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, floods, drought, hurricanes and cyclones. These situations are often called 'natural disasters', but many situations are worsened by environmentally harmful human activity including climate change and deforestation.                              |
| Q. Partners         | 17. A sense of what is good and fair together with a feeling to do what is right.  |
| R. Refugees         | 18. A person who owing to a well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group, or political opinion, is outside the country of their nationality, and is unable to or, owing to such fear, is unwilling to avail him/herself of the protection of that country |
| S. Sharing          | 19. A group with common interests.   |
| T. Stewardship      | 20. A dynamic church-based social justice movement.  |
