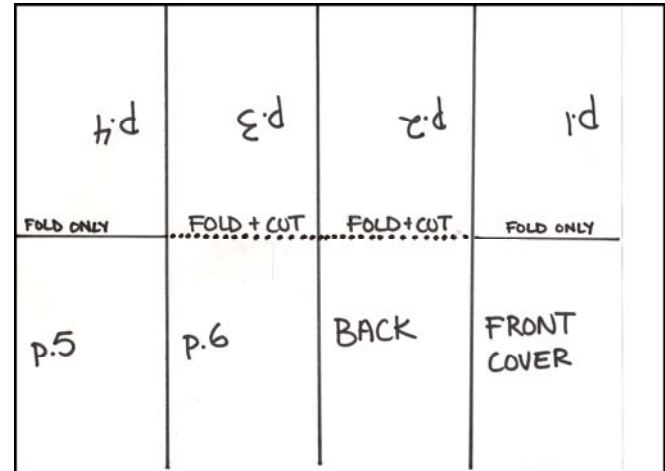
These instructions are for an 8 page zine made with 8.5"x11" paper.

1. Create the pages.

Fold the paper in half length-wise.

Open it up and fold again width-wise, twice.

When you open it up you should have eight sections, these fold marks will designate your pages.



2. Create the book by folding in half widthwise again and cutting through the first fold, about 2 3/4". Do not cut through to the edge.

3. Fold up your booklet.

Fold lengthwise again holding at the edges with your fingers at the front cover and p.5. push these edges toward the centre and see how the cut you made fans out the centre pages. Fold the book along the front and back cover fold and enclose the pages inside. Once the book is closed sharpen this fold so that it holds its shape.



4. Add your content.

You may find it easier to lay your book flat to work on it – you can also use the other side for a full page layout if you want to add a picture or a message that fills the whole page. Consider including: what's the problem? why I care? what can we do? ideas; challenges, quotes, PWRDF stories and information, pictures, maps, statistics? questions from your friends? biblical quotes, song lyrics – whatever inspires you. Important: If you are working on your book while it is flat open, remember that the pages on one side of the lengthwise fold are upside down. Add page numbers, or arrows in pencil if you wish.

5. Share it.
