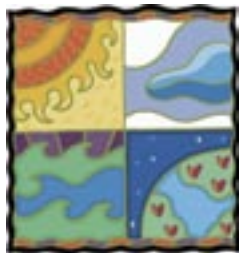


Enough for All – Care for Creation

- ◀ contamination of air by toxic emissions from industries and vehicles
- ◀ water pollution by industrial, agricultural, and human wastes
- ◀ prevalence of acid rain, which damages forests, lakes, and streams

- ◀ climate change, caused by the build-up of greenhouse gases, especially carbon dioxide.

Programs addressing gender, health, education, agriculture, renewable energy, income generation, water, sanitation, and emergency response are making a real difference in people's lives.

We are all a part of Creation, not separate from it. We are called by God to be the caretakers of Creation. Together, let us think globally and act locally.

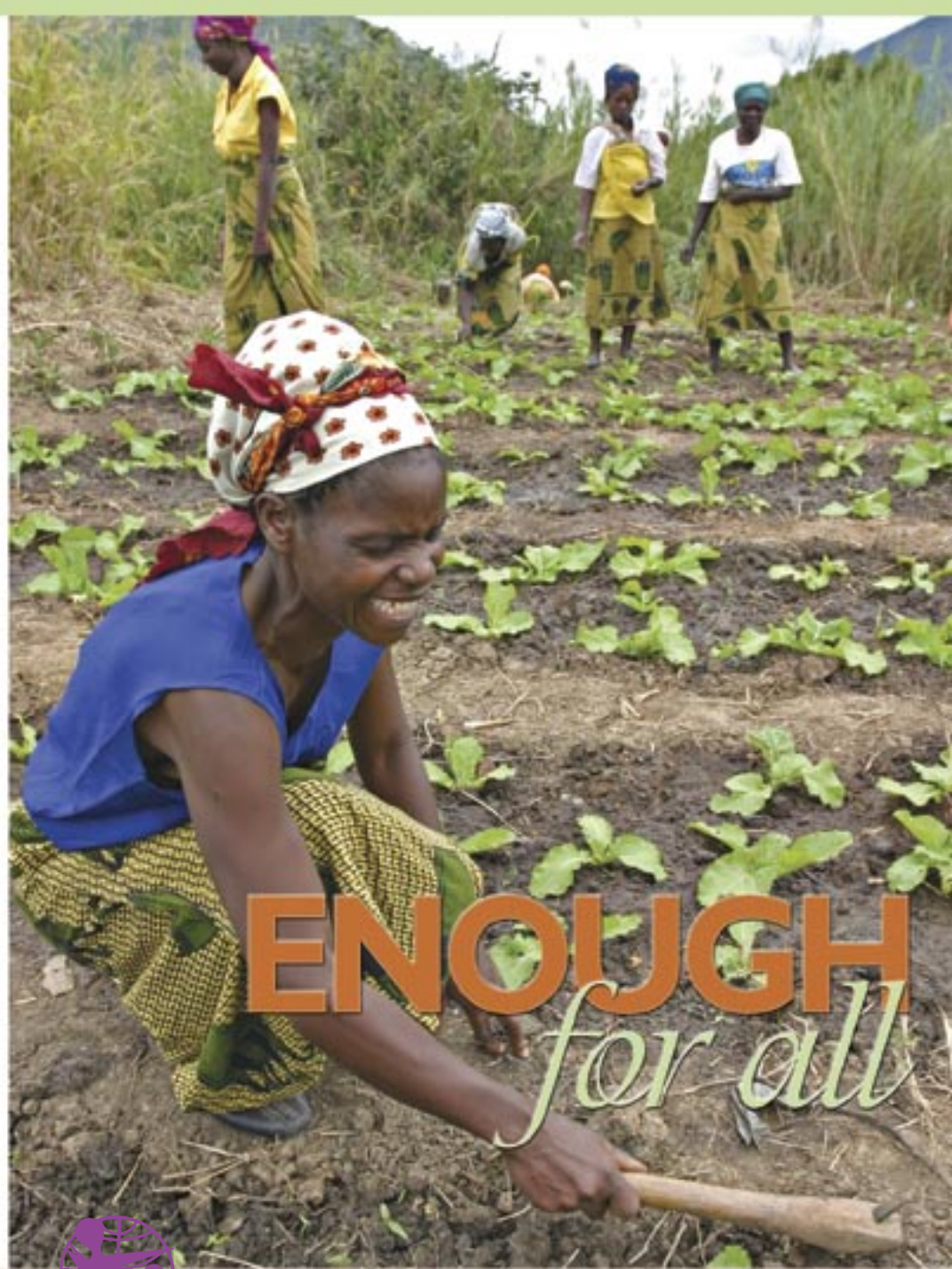
