Placemat Ideas

- ⊙ Use at your fundraising, educational, or celebration lunch following a focused service of worship
- ⊙ Use at a food related event where you want to encourage thought and conversation about the development and relief efforts of your congregation and/or denomination
- ⊙ Laminate a few and use them weekly as part of your coffee hour set up or snack time within the children's program.



Offering Envelope Ideas

- ⊙ Use this as an insert in conjunction with the bulletin cover or worship service
- ⊙ Seek permission to have it in the pews or other location in the worship space on a regular basis as one option for people to give
- ⊙ Use as appropriate for special celebrations or as part of a life celebration or remembrance
- ⊙ Designate a particular season and/or Sunday to focus on development and make the envelopes available during this time.

Care for Creation Calendar and Container Label Ideas

- ⊙ Use the Care for Creation calendar with the container label to **PRAY**, **ACT**, and **GIVE** for **Enough for All**.
- ⊙ Follow instructions on the label. Encourage creativity and do not limit this activity to the young in your congregation. It might be a quick intergenerational activity within the service or coffee hour. Be sure to make up extras and have them available.
- ⊙ If you use them during a designated season, be sure to support their use with regular reminders in the bulletin. Share stories of how the money is making a difference.
- ⊙ Celebrate the return of containers and collection of envelopes within the offering time. Share stories of how the money is making a difference for people.

Tips for use

Service of Worship Ideas

- ⊙ This is a complete service with music choices and leadership notes. Use it during your outreach or development focused Sunday or when lay leadership is celebrated. Use it in a service when your congregation is exploring its vision or celebrating the year.
- ⊙ Use elements of this service in your regular worship. Please acknowledge the source.
- ⊙ Adapt it to fit your local tradition, such as weekly communion.

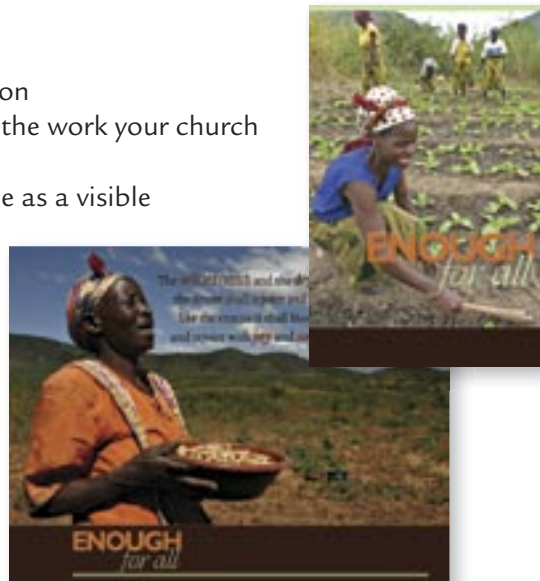


Bulletin Cover Ideas

- ⊙ Use these on the Sunday your worship service highlights PWS&D/PWRDF/WDR
- ⊙ Use these on a Sunday when you might be exploring your congregation's vision or celebrating the year, such as an annual meeting.

Poster Ideas

- ⊙ Put it up in a prominent location
- ⊙ Develop a display highlighting the work your church does to provide Enough for All
- ⊙ Laminate it and place it outside as a visible statement of your church's commitment
- ⊙ Use as an example for small groups to develop their own art. Encourage people to draw or create a collage that reflects their own actions to create Enough for All.
